#### Specific equipments:

- Front carrying handle.
- Front and back tow hooks.
- Front inflation valve to free the back part.
- 8 strengthened anchor points for a seat or shell use when practicing in the sitting position : multi-adjustable positions from "crusing" to "wave".
- 2 front grab handles to surf when lying down or hold on to it.
- 2 side handles for the instructor's lying position when used in pairs / also allows to seat properly.
- 2 handles to climb from the back.
